

Missions Prayer Request July 2019

Dick Eastman, International President of 'Every Home for Christ', shares the following concepts in his book, The Change the World School of Prayer (pages 149-153) to help the student of prayer focus on serious needs:

- 1. We should focus our prayer on local and world leaders (1 Timothy 2:1-2b).
 - 2. We should focus prayer on individual nations and people groups.

Jesus wants us to include all the nations of the world in our praying for His kingdom to come. A world map is helpful in reminding us of these many nations.

- 3. We should focus prayer on "all people" in addition to leaders in authority (1 Timothy 2:1).
 - 4. We should focus prayer on the need for laborers.
- 5. We should focus prayer on the need for revival as well as the harvest of souls.
 - 6. We should focus prayer on new converts.

Ask the Lord to surround them with His glory and to cause ministering angels to protect them. Praying for their spiritual growth in Christ is also very important.

7. We should focus prayer on the national churches of other lands.

Devoted workers there know both the culture and the language—a huge help in international missions efforts.

8. We should focus prayer on missionary organizations and their needs.

For us, this especially would include our SBC International Mission Board (IMB) and the North American Mission Board (NAMB).

E. M. Bounds, born in 1835, is a man for all ages. His insight into what really matters in living for Christ transcends any particular denomination or doctrinal setting. He was convicted that Almighty God still loves to hear His people pour out their hearts to Him in prayer and has promised to respond with blessing and power.

Bounds' books on prayer stimulate and inspire Christians to become prayer warriors.

Bounds wrote, "If prayer puts God to work on earth, then, by the same token, prayerlessness rules God out of the world's affairs, and prevents Him from working. In reality the denial of prayer is a denial of God Himself, for God and prayer are so inseparable that they can never be divorced." [The Weapon of Prayer, Reprinted 1975 by Baker Book House, p. 22.]

"Hope Beyond Despair"

Ephesians 5:6 says, "Redeeming the time, because the days are evil." Of course this is the King James Version rendering of this verse.

The Amplified Version translates it in this fashion: "Making the very most of your time [on earth, recognizing and taking advantage of each opportunity and using it with wisdom and diligence], because the days are [filled with] evil."

No doubt we can all attest to this truth in our world today. All it takes is a simple opening of the morning newspaper or quick glance at your smartphone and immediately brokenness hits you in the face. Best selling author Phillip Yancey, in his article "Living in a Broken World" chronicles one of his more daunting tasks when asked to address the community of Newtown, Connecticut following the aftermath of the Sandy Hook shooting that took the lives of 20 first graders and six of their teachers and staff members in 2012.

"That weekend I heard firsthand accounts of the tragedy from affected families and also counselors, first responders and staff from Sandy Hook Elementary School. Among the adults I talked to, I sensed no spirit of revenge, rather bewilderment and deep sadness. No one had a clue to the "why us?" questions.

The surviving children were coping in different ways. Anger flared in some. Others showed signs of panic attacks and anxiety, fearful of going back to school.

What happened at Sandy Hook was a parent's darkest nightmare. By God's grace, most children will never experience that particular kind of tragedy."

Most, if not all, vividly recall the images of horror that filled our television screens of this demonic act of violence that took place December 14, 2012. I mean...why? Why would ANYONE want to take the lives of innocent human beings and especially beautiful, innocent children? Dear GOD...how can anyone be so evil?

The truth is...trying to provide reasoning for such horrible atrocities is impossible. However, according to the Scriptures, we can provide a cause. Satan himself. In the book of Isaiah chapter 14:16 we read the following...

"Those who see you will gaze at you, They will ponder over you, saying, 'Is this the man who made the earth tremble...(?)"

For reasons beyond human comprehension, God, in His own sovereignty, has given Satan latitude to roam the earth, persecuting Christians and causing all sorts of hurt and pain throughout all of creation. Ever since the Fall, creation as a whole, has been under the curse of sin and will remain so until God's perfect redemptive plan (New Heaven and New Earth; Destruction of Satan) has been fulfilled. (Romans 8:18-22; Revelation 20:7-9)

But just to think...he (Satan) has the 'power' now to make the "earth to tremble" in desperation and hopelessness?! Pretty depressing isn't it...or is it? Let's go back to the Scriptures. In Colossians 2:13-15 we read...

"When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public display of them, having triumphed over them through Him."

According to Paul and more importantly the Holy Spirit Himself, Satan is like a rabid dog, but one that has been de-fanged. In other words, he's hasn't one single solitary tooth in his head to actually thwart God's ultimate plans in each of our lives. Sure...he growls and snarls each and every day, but God has "disarmed" him from being able to ultimately defeat the hope that lies within each of us. (I Peter 3:15)

Therefore friends...be encouraged today no matter what befalls you. God has a perfect plan that's far beyond anything you can imagine and he'll never let Satan have the final say in your lives.

"For I know the plans that I think towards you says the Lord. Thoughts of peace...not of evil, but to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11
