

We grow in our faith and in our love for God as we daily practice "Spiritual Disciplines". Last month we discussed reading God's word and prayer.

This month, let's think more about prayer and about Christian meditation.

Some situations are so traumatic and painful you don't know how to pray... "Mercy, Lord, mercy" may be the only words your soul can form in prayer. When you don't know how to pray, God prays for you through the Holy Spirit. (See Romans 8:26-30.)

Release your confusion, pain, and trauma into God's perfect knowledge, power, and love.

Allow the beauty and mystery of the Holy Spirit's prayer to wash over you. Let gratitude well up and spill out in love for God's perfection and steadfast love toward you. Breathe deeply and rest in this marvelous gift of God's grace and peace.

Pray for people who live in great darkness and confusion about God. Pray for missionaries who labor to bring the beautiful light of God's grace to them.

Meditating on God's word is a spiritual practice with many benefits. (See Psalm 119:97-104.) First, your faith in God grows when you prioritize time to meditate. This focus on scripture requires a mind uncluttered by distractions. So from what might you need to be freed in order to create space for prayer and meditation?

Second, you fill your mind with God's word, works, and attributes when you meditate. Like the psalmist, you become like a well-watered tree bearing much kingdom fruit. Meditating on God's word pleases Him.

A missionary's day is filled with many responsibilities and activities. Pray for time to study and meditate on God's word and for opportunities to teach others this spiritual discipline.

I was on the third floor of Taylor Hall, Campbell University. It was a beautiful September morning and life was good. At exactly 8:45am EST, a Boeing 767 loaded with 20,000 gallons of jet fuel crashed into the North tower of the World Trade Center. Shortly after the first impact, one of the religion professors was heard hollering in disbelief of the events unfolding before our very eyes. Almost instantaneously every student on the entire floor crowded around the small 30 inch TV located in the student lounge. No one could believe what they were seeing. Not a word was spoken.

Now...18 years later, it still seems as if it were yesterday. As President Franklin D. Roosevelt said in reference to the attack at Pearl Harbor... "a date that will live in infamy." Likewise September 11, 2001 will also live in each of our hearts till our final days.

In consideration, this coming Wednesday September 11, I'm planning to do a study of remembrance that very evening to commemorate the 18<sup>th</sup> anniversary of that fateful day. My hope and prayer is that many of you will make your plans to be a part of this very special service. In addition to our time of study, I have a very special video to share with each of you. I can promise you...this will be one service you'll not want to miss.
