Missions Prayer Request

November 2019

In this Prayer Request, we consider once again Lucretia Mobbs' "Prayer Patterns" in the July 2019 Missions Mosaic. She has been discussing "Spiritual Disciplines" which help us grow in our faith and in our love for God. This month, we will end this series as we consider solitude and fasting.

"The spiritual discipline of solitude weans you from the world's distractions and forges a deeper connection to God... It sounds nice, but where's the time? [We could] pray in the quiet moments before getting out of bed. [Or we might] go outdoors as the last light falls and thank God for His creation."

*"Some missionaries live in places opposed to God. **Pray** for their times alone with Him to be frequent and rich."*

*"Missionaries are praying and listening for God's direction. **Pray** against the enemy's noise around them."*

"A broad definition of fasting is voluntarily abstaining from a normal function for the sake of spiritual purposes. Some fast from food, technology, or shopping." (Note: Always check with your doctor before a food fast.)

Perhaps we are realizing that we might be addicted to entertainment. Maybe a media fast would open up time and energy for us to engage in God's work.

"Why has fasting fallen by the wayside, even though Jesus expects His followers to fast? Could it be our conditioning to be comfortable at all costs? Meditate on Jesus' practice of fasting and ask God how you should incorporate this spiritual practice into your life."

*We fast for God's guidance and protection, to strengthen our prayers, and to confirm God's will. "Missionaries fast and pray for their work. Seek God's favor by **praying** and fasting for them and for their work."*

Other spiritual disciplines which we will not discuss in this series of Prayer Request articles include: simplicity, contentment, confession of our sins, humble service, hospitality, worshipping God, giving, and gratitude.

*All spiritual disciplines are important to our spiritual growth, but don't turn that growth into just keeping a list of rules. As Ms. Mobbs says, "**Listen, learn, and obey the Holy Spirit. Immerse yourself in the whole Word of God and trust your heart to Him.**"*
